I would be grateful if you could make public the results of your investigation into the alleged breaking of Regulations by Sir Keir Starmer and others during the Covid-19 pandemic.

On 30 April 2021 Sir Keir and a considerable number of other people were photographed drinking beer and eating indoors after some constituency campaigning in Durham.

Given that FPNs and fines have been imposed on other people for similar or lesser infringements, it is in the public interest to know how the Durham Police Service is dealing with the Leader of the Labour Party
