

Durham Constabulary -

Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Report

Period 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019

Prescribed groups and public sector bodies with 250 or more staff in England have a target to employ an average of at least 2.3% of their staff as new apprentice starts over the periods of 1st April 2017 to 31st March 2021. Bodies in scope, must have regard to the target.

Durham Constabulary's submission for the period 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019 – has been uploaded to the National Apprentice Service portal / Department for Education.
