



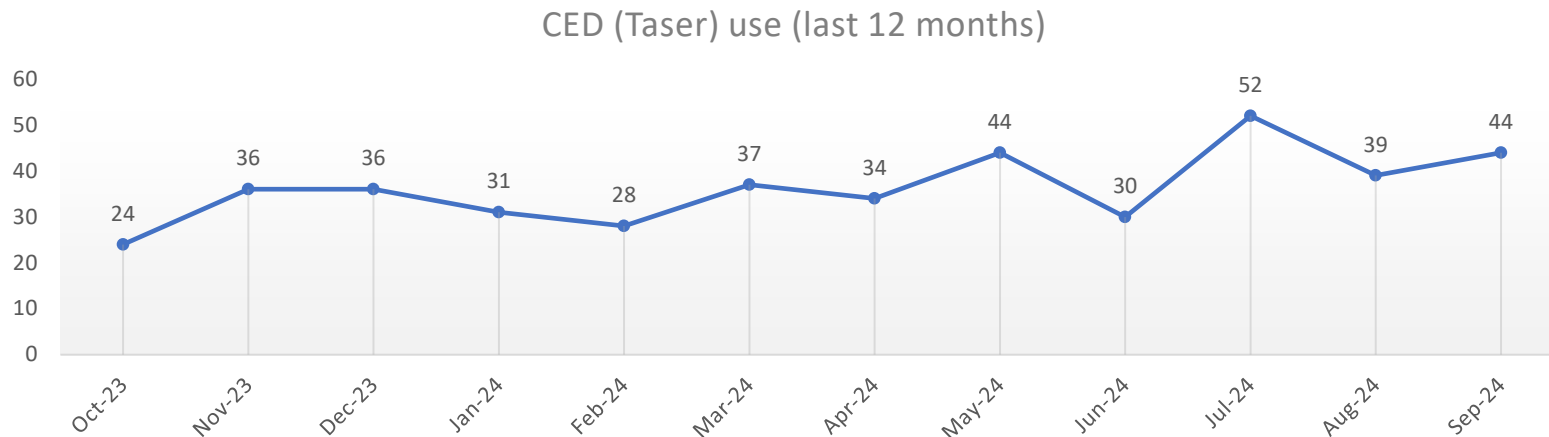

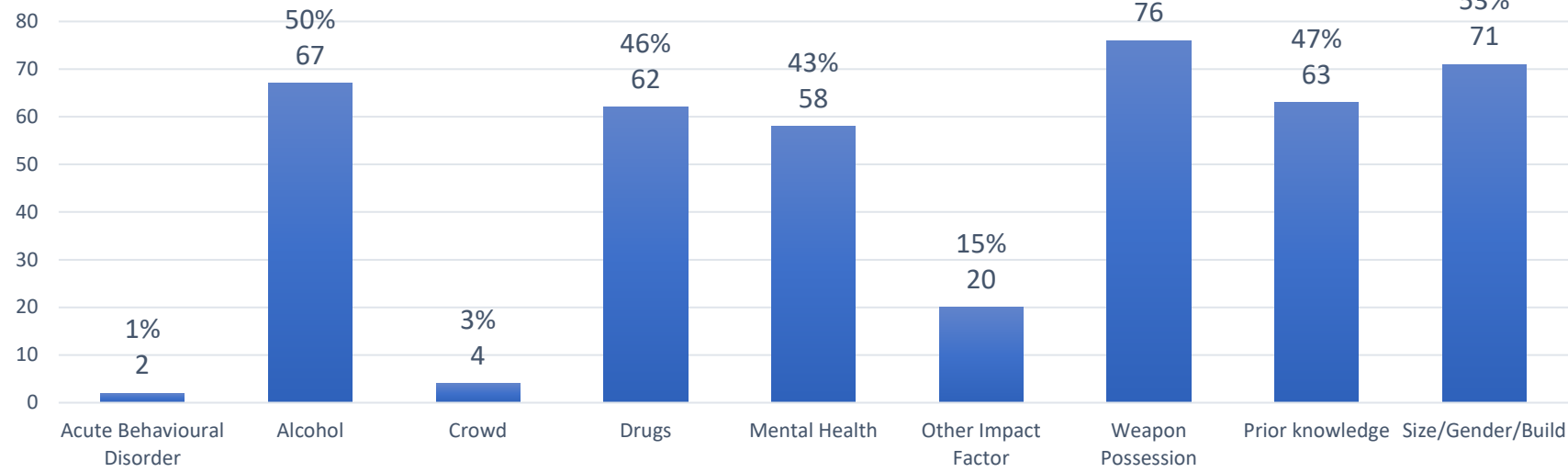

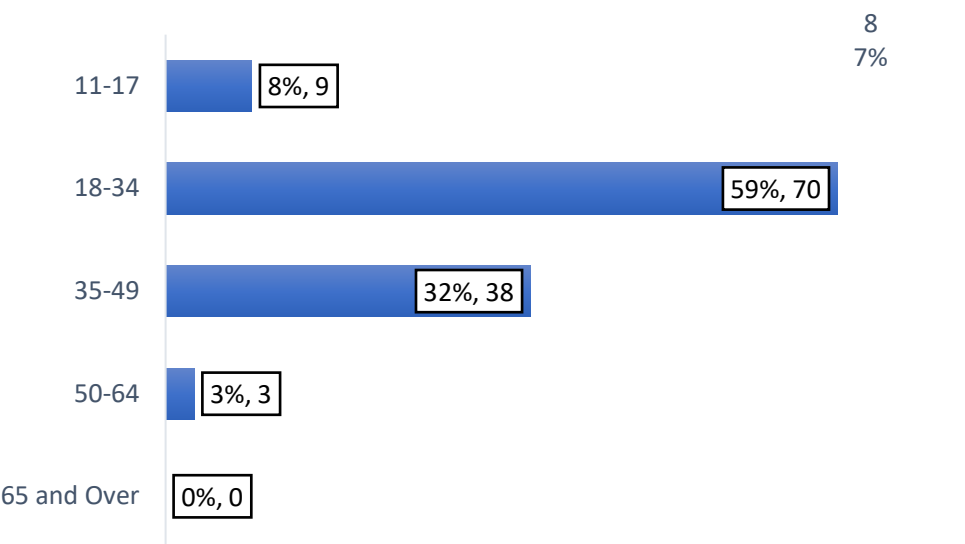

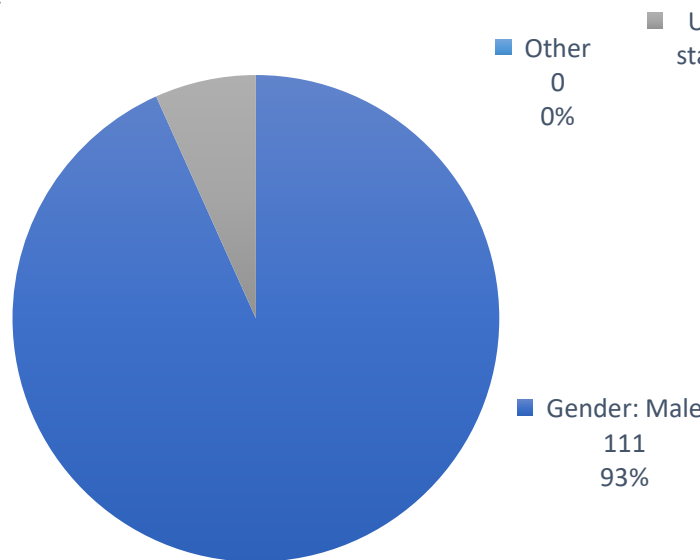

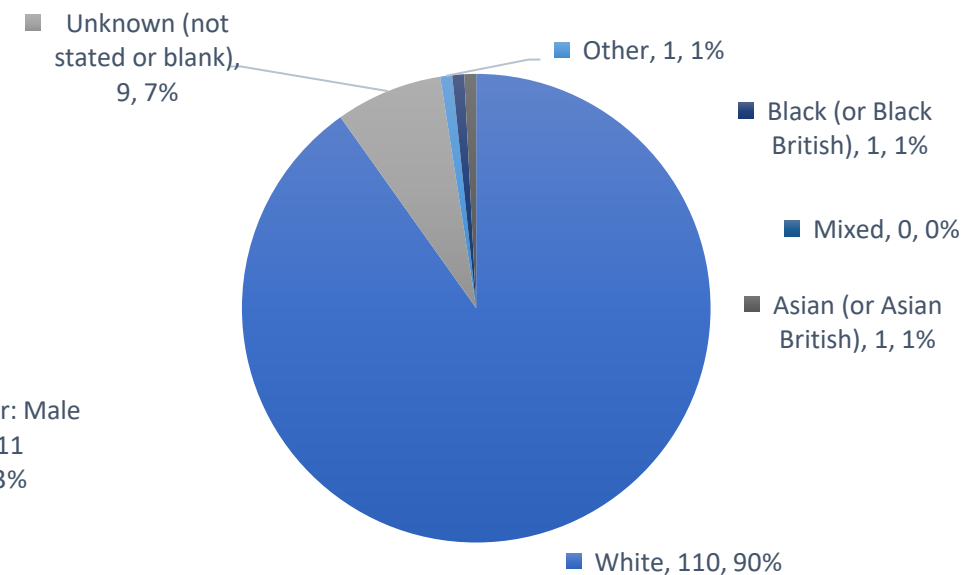
Age Group - Q2 2024/2025
